Overview of Duties

- Responsible for the design and integration of the Command, Control, Communications, Computers, Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance (C4ISR) systems, to include the investigation and resolution of system interface issues, the selection of C4ISR equipment, and oversight of the testing at the Production Facility.
- Provide system integration and design technical support for the C4ISR Detail Design of the USCG Offshore Patrol Cutter (OPC) design.
- Ensure the logical and systematic conversion of Contract requirements into C4ISR systems solutions that acknowledge technical, schedule, and cost constraints.
- Create and manage the development and production of the C4ISR software and hardware.
- Direct and coordinate with project stakeholders to ensure quality deliverables are submitted in accordance with the Contract requirements.
- Oversee the development of the Production Facility.
- Support and execute a robust C4 test program at a dedicated production facility in Panama City, shipboard and Navy INSURV acceptance trials.
- Maintain OPC C4ISR development in accordance with contract specifications, ABS, NVR and Eastern Shipbuilding Group, Inc. design specifications.
- Maintain interface with the Technical Director on all aspects of C4ISR design.
- Create reports and metrics on OPC C4ISR development progress.
- Maintain, manage and resolve integration and C4ISR system issues.

Qualifications

- Ability to obtain and maintain a SECRET security clearance.
- Bachelor's degree in Engineering plus ten years cumulative experience in acquisition, management, development, installation, or testing of a C4ISR systems on a maritime vessel. An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.
- Intermediate Microsoft Word, Excel, PowerPoint and Project skill level.
- Ability to read and interpret documents such as general business periodicals, professional journals, technical procedures, governmental regulations and Company policies/procedures.
- Ability to conduct extensive reviews of various design documents to ensure they meet Contract specifications prior to submission to Government.
- Ability to lead multi-system integrated product teams.
- Effective written and verbal communication skills to carry out and understand assignments, and/or convey or exchange routine information.
