- Provide technical support investigation and resolution of IPT system interface issues related to all C4ISR systems.
- Prepare reports and metrics on OPC development progress.
- Maintain, manage and resolve integration and system engineering issues.

Qualifications

- Ability to obtain and maintain a SECRET security clearance.
- Bachelor's degree in Engineering plus 10 yrs. cumulative experience in participation with any role in the acquisition, management, development, installation, or testing of a C4ISR system on a maritime vessel. An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.
- DoD and DHS experience required.
- Must have accurate written and verbal communication skills to carry out and understand assignments, and/or convey or exchange routine information.
- Excellent written, oral, and presentation/communication skills are required, and successful candidate must have the ability to rapidly obtain, sort, filter, and analyze large volumes of data for distillation into high-level reports utilizing Microsoft Office including Excel and Word.
