## Chief Naval Architect

### Overview of Duties

- Work closely with the VP, Engineering and various project teams in resolving issues with regard to day to day operations.
- Responsible for performing a variety of calculations applying naval architecture principles, techniques, procedures, and criteria.
- Assist VP, Engineering in meeting production schedules, maintaining resources and training needs within the Engineering Dept.
- Communicate daily with other engineers and supporting staff to assess and immediately solve issues.
- Supervise and lead engineers and designers plan and development projects and oversee scheduling and job performance.
- Discuss and lay out project requirements.
- Make detailed engineering scheduling and resource plans to accomplish goals.
- Review, approve, or modify detailed engineering designs and prepare information to consult directly with VP, Engineering.
- Assist in the development of cost estimates for engineering work to perform on specific projects.
- Draft reports for management on status of engineering projects, schedule, status of deliverables to Company Production Dept., Class and Statutory approval, and any other relevant information affecting the overall project development. Improve detail design processes within the Engineering Dept.
- Develop administrative policies, procedures, and standards within the Engineering Dept., for review/ approval by senior management.
- Provide technical direction, serve as a point of contact or liaison, prepare briefings for senior management and assist in problem resolution specific to the project.
- Regular attendance at work and the ability to work flexible hours, including overtime, weekends, and holidays.

### Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree in Naval Architecture or Marine Engineering, plus seven or more years' experience as a Naval Architect in ship design, construction, and repair of marine vessels. Prior supervisory experience desired. An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.
- Requires a good working knowledge of ABS rules.
- Working knowledge of Lloyd's and DNV rules a plus. Lofting and structural design proficiency a plus.
- Requires intermediate to advanced level Microsoft Word, Excel and Outlook experience and proficiency in AutoCAD, Ship Constructor and standard naval architecture software.
- Ability to read, analyze and interpret professional journals, technical procedures, or governmental regulations required.
- Ability to effectively present information and respond to questions from groups of managers, clients, customers, senior management and government officials.
- Ability to solve practical problems and deal with a variety of variables in situations where only limited standardization exists.
- Ability to interpret a variety of instructions furnished in written, oral, diagram, or schedule form.
