Overview of Duties

- Operate Company owned/leased trucks and buses to facilitate shipping and receiving operations and transporting employees. Perform various warehouse duties including loading and unloading of materials and/or equipment.
- Transport raw materials and finished goods various distances over land from one shipyard location to another or to and from retail/distribution centers.
- Perform required before-, during-, and after-operation inspections, completing all required documentation. Report defects, accidents or violations.
- Comply with driving rules and regulations (size, weight, and break periods, etc.) as well as with Company policies and procedures.
- Maintain records required for compliance with state and federal regulations, including driver's logs, mileage records, and other records required by law and Company policies and procedures.
- Ensure all administrative paperwork concerning delivery of materials/equipment accompanies the delivery.
- Operate and maintain equipment in a safe manner.
- Perform inventory and property control duties.
- Regular attendance at work and the ability to work flexible hours, including overtime, weekends, and holidays.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
