### Overview of Duties

- Responsible for design calculations and drawing development as it pertains to each vessel.
- Coordinate updates/changes with affected departments, crafts, and project managers, etc.

- Function as a project engineer, design and oversee design for the construction and repair of marine craft and floating structures such as ships, barges, and tugs.
- Review designs and calculations to find potential construction issues. Interact with the crafts when issues arise and use engineering knowledge and experience to properly research or calculate the correct solution.
- Research and analyze data, such as customer design proposal, specifications, and manuals to determine feasibility of design or application.
- Inspect, evaluate, and arrange field installations and recommend design modifications to eliminate machine or systems malfunctions.
- Regular attendance at work and the ability to work flexible hours, including overtime, weekends, and holidays.

- Bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering, plus three to five years' experience in ship design, construction, and/or repair of marine vessels. An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.
