Overview of Duties

- Perform in-process and final inspections on government shipbuilding projects. Interact with the Company's Project Construction Team members, subcontractors, government and ABS representatives.
- Conduct daily checks/inspections to ensure compliance to contract requirements.
- Interface with Craft Superintendents, Production, Planning Department and Customer Representatives.
- Assist Quality Assurance Manager to develop Process Control Procedures, a QA Test and Inspection Plans for assigned contract/availabilities and address Corrective Action Reports (CARs).
- Perform and document in-process and final inspections to prevent defects and non-compliance for hull, structural and pipe welding.
- Document and report deficient work and make recommendations for corrective actions.
- Verify check points identified in the specifications; ensure all completed work meets specification requirements.
- Monitor Craft personnel and subcontractor of in-process work; document deficient work on a non-conformance reports and follow up on corrective actions taken.
- Perform ship hull, structural and pipe fabrication, installation quality assurance inspections, verifications and associated tests.
- Verify contract specifications, drawings, and shipbuilding standards to ensure compliance.
- Conduct visual inspection of piping systems.
- Process CARs, non-conformance reports and trial cards.
- Support and participate in dock trials, Builders and Navy Board of INSERV Acceptance Trials.
- Provide technical support for engineering changes.
- Work with minimal supervision.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
- Regular attendance at work and the ability to work flexible hours, including overtime, weekends, and holidays.

Qualifications

- High school diploma or GED equivalence plus three or more years of maritime/ship construction/repair and/or shipbuilding related industry experience desired or Navy/Coast Guard experience. Previous Auxiliary equipment and system installation, validation and testing experience required. Requires previous pipe Visual Inspection and Non-Destructive Testing Level II experience and previous experience in Quality Control and/or Quality Assurance. An equivalent combination of educations and/or experience may be considered.
- NACE Paint Preservation certification background desired.
- Hull and structural production welding and Non-Destructive Testing Level II experience with PT/MT/UT.
- Requires three or more years' experience with government contracts and specifications.
- Intermediate to advanced level Microsoft Word, Excel and PowerPoint experience required.
- Ability to read and interprets drawing requirements, governments specifications, work specification requirements, NAVSEA Standard Items, Mil Specs and ABS Naval Vessel Rules and Steel Vessel Rules.
- Effective written, oral, and presentation/ communication skills required.
- Ability to work both independently and as part of a team.
- Ability to work in a fast-paced environment and multi-task.
