Overview of Duties:

- Responsible for gathering vendor and other types of information, use AutoCAD and function with other engineering tools used at ESG including FORAN and ShipConstructor3D modeling software, undertake work under the supervision and instructions by engineering staff using requirements documents, ship specifications, shipyard standards, and regulatory body requirements.
- Create and develop production drawings for arrangement, wire ways, lighting, installation details, develop/maintain cable pull lists, equipment lists and undertake basic calculations subject to review by engineering staff.
- Responsible for identifying/verifying routinely used parts, equipment and other materials in the production drawings subject to review by engineering staff.
- Regular attendance at work and the ability to work flexible hours, including overtime, weekends, and holidays.
