Overview of Duties:

- Overall responsibility for compliance with testing/trials procedures stipulated under the U.S. Coast Guard Offshore Patrol Cutter (OPC) program contract.
- Support and execute a robust total ship test program including development of test processes and procedures, test report templates, and management of testing at a dedicated production facility (in Panama City, FL), shipboard and Navy INSURV acceptance trials.
- Provide Briefings and metrics for the ship's total test plan and schedule of tests.
- Manage competing priorities of all Testing and Activation projects to delivery results within financial and schedule specifications. Support production, test, launch, and trials Readiness Reviews.
- Lead Pre- and Post-Sea Trials meetings.
- Maintain all Test Metrics and communicate timely to the program office.
- Coordinate with Engineering and Project Management to ensure that the shipyard testing strategy is being followed.
- Regular attendance at work and the ability to work flexible hours, including overtime, weekends, and holidays.

Qualifications:

- Ability to obtain and maintain a SECRET security clearance.
- Bachelor's degree in engineering or related studies plus a minimum of 5 years' experience shipboard (USCG/USN) testing, developing procedures, performing test validation, verifying prerequisites, and documentation into deliverable test reports. Experience with integration of a test program into Program Integrated Master Schedule (IMS), starting with design through fabrication, construction, and delivery required. An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.
- Experience with Contract Design Requirements List (CDRL) Development and Management preferred. Experience developing test procedures using American Bureau of Shipping (ABS) using Naval Vessel Rules (NVR) requirements highly desired.
- Intermediate to Advanced level Microsoft Office including Word, Excel and PowerPoint required.
- Ability to read, analyze, and interpret, professional journals, technical procedures, or governmental regulations.
- Ability to interpret contract requirements, specifications, and drawings, into comprehensive test program.
- Ability to prepare and brief presentations of test program to internal and external management teams.
- Ability to effectively present information and respond to questions from management, government officials, and the public.
- Must have accurate written and verbal communication skills to carry out and understand assignments, and/or convey or exchange routine information.
- Ability to rapidly obtain, sort, filter, and analyze large volumes of data for distillation into high-level reports.
- Requires experience working both independently and as part of the OPC team with the ability to exercise diplomacy and tact
