

# OPC Hull Manager

## Job Summary

Responsible for the day to day coordination of sub-contractors during construction of the vessel. Review of drawings for MTOs and requisition requests. Routine review of drawings to ensure compliance with contract specifications. Review requisitions and purchase orders to ensure specifications are complied with for each item. Engineering interface with regard to build/fab capability and material capability.

Prepare weekly production meeting agenda for craft as related to the project. Coordinate with regulatory bodies during construction of the vessel. Represent Company when meeting with vessel representatives. Daily coordination with production with regards to material and drawing needs for each phase of construction. Responsible for updates to management as needed or required. Regular attendance at work and the ability to work flexible hours, including overtime, weekends, and holidays. Perform other duties as assigned.
