

QA Inspector -- Structural – 1st Class

Job Summary

Under the direction of the Quality Assurance Supervisor perform in-process and final inspections on government shipbuilding projects. Interact with the Company's Project Construction Team members, subcontractors, government, and ABS representatives.

Job Duties

- Conduct daily checks/inspections to ensure compliance to contract requirements, ESG QMS, drawings and shipboard standards.
- Interface with Ship Superintendents, Production, ABS, Outfitting Coordinators, Project Management and USCG Representatives.
- Assist OPC QA Manager and OPC QA Supervisor in developing Process Control Procedures (PCPs), QA Test and Inspection Plan (TIP), addressing Corrective Action Reports (CARs) and Non-Conformance Reports (NCR).
- Document and report deficient work and make recommendations for corrective actions.
- Monitor Craft personnel and subcontractors of in-process and final work; document deficient work on a non-conformance report and follow up on corrective actions taken.
- Coordinate and conduct checkpoint signoffs with USCG and ABS of completed Units.
- Verify contract specifications, drawings, and shipbuilding standards to ensure compliance.
- Conduct visual inspection of fit-ups, welds, brazes, alignments, blue fits, etc.
- Assist OPC QA Manager and OPC QA Supervisor in processing CARs, non-conformance reports and trial cards.
- Support and participate in dock trials (DT), Builders (BT) and Navy Board of INSERV Acceptance Trials (AT) as needed.
- Ability to read and interpret Engineering drawings (blueprints) is required.
- Assist with obtaining technical support for engineering changes.
- Work with minimal supervision.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
- Regular attendance at work and the ability to work flexible hours, including overtime, weekends, and holidays.
