Job Duties

- Provide system integration and design technical support for the C4ISR Detail Design of the USCG Offshore Patrol Cutter (OPC) design.
- Support and execute a robust C4 test program at a dedicated production facility in Panama City, shipboard and Navy INSURV acceptance trials.
- Maintain OPC C4ISR development in accordance with contract specifications, ABS, NVR and ESG design specifications.
- Maintain interface with C4ISR Manager on all aspects of C4ISR design.
- Prepare reports and metrics on OPC C4ISR development progress.
- Maintain, manage and resolve integration and system engineering issues.
- Perform other duties as instructed.
- Regular attendance at work and the ability to work flexible hours, including overtime, weekends, and holidays.
